

"Empathy among young people has declined significantly over the past few decades.

A University of Michigan study, which analyzed data on empathy from almost 14,000 college students gathered between 1979 and 2009, found a 48% decrease in empathetic concern and a 34% decrease in perspective taking, which is the ability to look at things from another person's point of view."


