Situation

Task 1 - Presentation (5 minutes)

- **Discuss** your motivations for choosing the volunteering project.
- **Explore** the qualities and skills important for the success of the project.
Consider how they connect with your own strengths and areas for growth.
- **Suggest** how you could contribute to the success of the project.
Provide examples of how you could make a positive impact on the community or cause.

Task 2 - Dialogue (7 minutes)

The interlocutor (talking partner) will start a conversation about some other aspects of the topic. Listen carefully and discuss the questions with her/him.
